S/he will be responsible for delivering high quality education and using teaching methodologies and curriculum in accordance with the school principal's guidelines. S/he will also take part in experiences'sharing and capacity building of Aide et Action Cambodia's community preschools' staff.

Responsibilities

- All daily responsibilities of regular classroom teaching specific to appropriate grade
- Teach preschool using teaching methodologies and educational approaches in compliance with the school's guidelines.
- Prepare lesson plans and produce quality resources
- Organize the classroom and create an environment conducive to learning
- Observe and record children's learning and development, produce a short report of students' progress every month
- Continuously engage parents in their child's education

- Provide training and technical support to community preschools' teachers
